Making a piggy bank out of items around the house is a win-win! It is a fun activity to do with your kid and it encourages children to save. Follow these 10 easy steps to make an upcycled plastic bottle a rocket ship bank that is out of this world.

MATERIALS NEEDED

- Empty plastic bottle
- Scissors
- Acrylic Paint
- Paint brush(s)
- Construction paper/ craft paper
- Foam board/ cardboard
- Glue
- Stickers (optional)
- Glitter (optional)
- Pipe cleaners (optional)

DIRECTIONS

- 1. With the use of a cutter and a pair of scissors, make a coin slot on the upper part of the bottle. Make sure that a single penny could fit into that slot.
- 2. Paint the empty plastic bottle the color you want your bank to be.
- 3. Draw a circle on construction or craft paper and cut it out. Draw a half line from the middle to the bottom part of the circle. Make sure that each side will be divided equally. Cut through the half line.
- 4. Roll the circle until you come up with a cone-shaped paper. Use glue to attach the cone into the cap of the bottle.
- 5. On a piece of cardboard or foam board, draw the fins of the rocket and put an extra half-inch sized on it. Cut out the fins and fold the extra half-inch. This will be later used to attach the fins to the body of the rocket.
- 6. Paint your rocket fins the color of your choice.
- 7. Once all painted pieces are dry, you can glue the rocket fins onto the bottle.
- 8. Use the construction and craft papers to cut out stars and other shapes for your rocket ship. You can also use stickers, glitter and pipe cleaners to decorate.
- 9. Let your new rocket ship bank dry.
- 10. Start saving!
